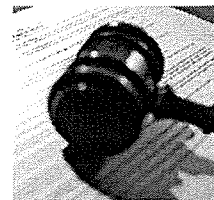


# SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2016 – 4-H Events - Manawa High School

## 1. Club Officer Training - November 12, 2016 at Manawa High School.

Registration begins at 9:00 a.m. Officer Training runs 9:15 - 11:30 a.m.



Are you a new club officer or would you like to learn more about conducting club meetings? If so, plan to attend Waupaca County 4-H Club Officer Training. At Officer Training you will participate in hands-on sessions to increase your understanding of each officer role. There will be sessions for: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Reporter, Historian, scrapbook, and Sunshine. We will also be learning some new ice breakers, club energizers, ideas about club environment, and more!

## 2. Annual Club Leader Training 9:45 - 11:15 a.m.

Annually, each 4-H Club and Committee that completes a charter is required to have at least one adult volunteer attend the annual club leader training. Last year this included E-Forums that were held at the Courthouse. Today, we will be viewing the e-forum entitled "The Heart of Belonging". If your club or committee still needs to meet this requirement for the 4-H year ending now you need to have somebody attend this session. Volunteers are also invited to attend that did not see this one last year and this will count for your club/committee requirement for 2016-2017. This e-forum will help you learn how to guide youth in developing a list of club or group expectations that accommodate all members, support youth with special needs, and discover resources to help you in your role as a caring adult.
